

INVITATION TO BID

The City of Hailey, Idaho, is accepting sealed bids at the office of the City Clerk, 115 Main Street, South, Suite H, Hailey Idaho, 83333, **until 2:00 P.M., prevailing local time, March 22, 2019**, for the following project:

TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM / MYRTLE STREET PATH / KEY NO. 20137

At 2:00 p.m. on the same day, all bid proposals will be opened publicly and read aloud in the Hailey City Hall council chambers.

The Bid Proposal will include:

A Base Bid consisting of construction of approximately 1,825 linear feet of 10'-wide, asphalt, shared-use path, including base preparation, driveway approaches, roadway shoulder repair, and re-grade existing stormwater drainage facilities, as necessary. Anticipated project design elements include a concrete block segmental structural retaining wall between 4th and 5th streets, relocation of an existing municipal water main, coordination of relocation of natural service gas line; coordination of relocation of fiber optic communication lines; minor landscaping and streetscape features adjacent to the path alignment, ADA-compliant pedestrian crossings at each intersection, and replacement of existing curb, gutter, and sidewalk at the Main Street intersection, including improvements of the existing pedestrian crossing at Main Street with ADA-compliant curb ramps and an updated pedestrian-activated, wireless, solar-powered crossing warning system and crosswalk pavement markings.

The Bid Proposals will be evaluated for contract award based on the Base Bid. If the Base Bid proposals are in excess of available construction funding, the Bid Proposals will be re-evaluated for contract award based on partial construction of the Base Bid, as determined by the City of Hailey.
