**Ice-Cream Social** July 4<sup>th</sup>, after the Parade -4pm at the Center in Hailey, 314 So. 2nd Ave.

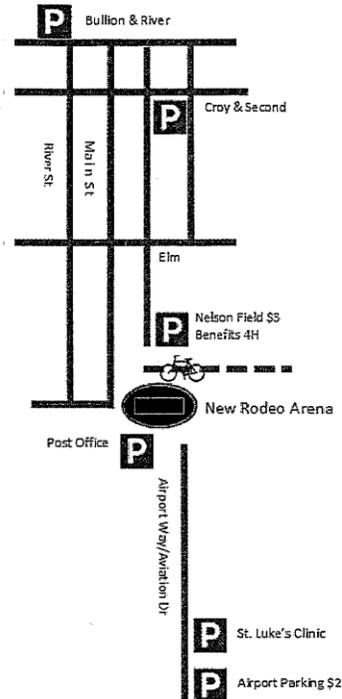
**4th of July Rodeo** by Sawtooth Rangers July 2<sup>nd</sup>, July 3<sup>rd</sup> (Family Nite - kids 10 & under free) & July 4<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m. Pre-events will start at 6:30. Tickets are sold at all Atkinsons' markets and at the Hailey Chamber in the Welcome Center 781 S. Main Street, in Hailey. All Tickets are General Admission (no reserved seating) this year. So get there early - 6:30pm suggested.

**Antique Fairs** July 4<sup>th</sup> -7<sup>th</sup>, Roberta McKercher Park and North Main Street (next to McDonalds).

**FIREWORKS !!!** July 4<sup>th</sup>, to conclude our wonderful tradition, fireworks this year will be accompanied by the performance of the 25th Army Band from Boise. Starts at dusk (9-9:30pm) at Fox Acres Park. Bring your picnic blanket or chair to enjoy this wonderful performance. You are encouraged to bike or walk. Parking is limited and will fill up fast!

### **Hailey July Fourth Weekend! Walk or Bike to the New Rodeo Arena July 2, 3 and 4th**

- Get to the arena from Main Street or from First Avenue from the Hailey Elementary School along Nelson Field.
- Bike parking is encouraged along the post and rail fence between the arena and Nelson ball field.
- If you are driving, parking spaces in Nelson Field; access is from First Avenue. A \$3 charge will help support the 4H Leaders Council.
- ADA parking is available, as always, close to the arena.
- Parking lots within a 10 to 15 minute walk (property owners have given permission to park in these lots for the rodeo event)
  - ▣ Post Office
  - ▣ St. Luke's Clinic- Aviation Drive
  - ▣ Airport over flow parking
  - ▣ Park and Ride lot at Bullion and River Street
  - ▣ Blaine County Courthouse at Croy Street and Second Avenue
- The Mountain Rides Valley Route will run on its normal schedule on Monday July 4th and is a great option for getting to the rodeo on July 4th.
