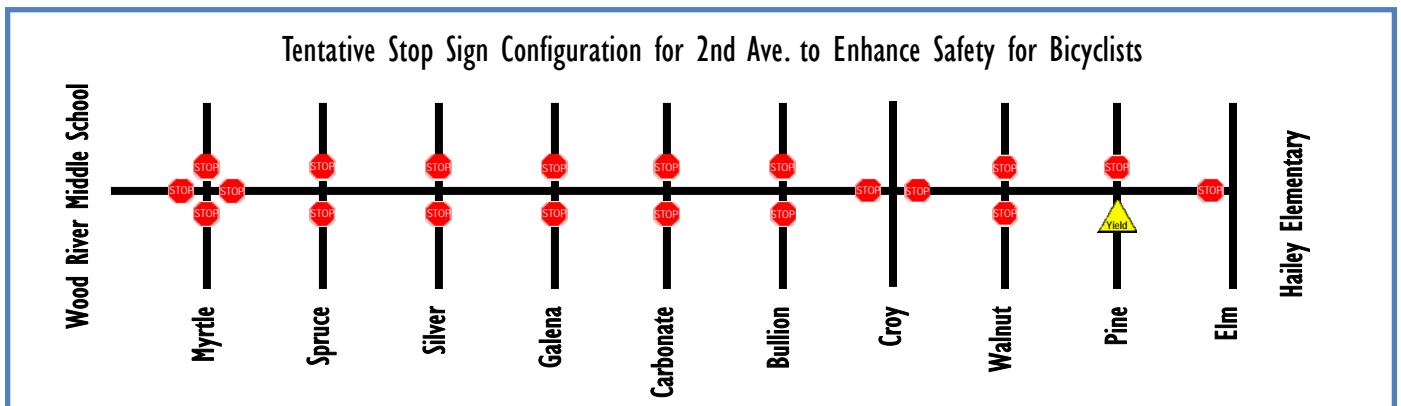
Separated, Two-Way Bicycle Lanes proposed for Croy St.

- Both directions of bicycle travel are contained within one facility, on only one side of the street (the south side of Croy St.)
- Physical separation from the vehicle travel lane for safety (removable curb stops or removable tubular markers proposed)
- Appropriate signage and pavement markings included



Dashed (or Advisory) Bicycle Lanes proposed for 2nd Ave.

- Modification of traditional bicycle lanes
- Bicycles stay in their designated bike lane
- Vehicles share a single travel lane
- Vehicles may cross over into a dashed bicycle lane for passing purposes (when an oncoming car is encountered), but only when bicycles are not present
- Appropriate signage and pavement markings included
- Stop sign changes are under consideration to enhance safety for bicyclists (see below)
