

The information below is a reminder of the fence requirements that apply in all zones and is taken from the Hailey Zoning Ordinance, Article VIII, 8.1 Fences.

The following requirements apply in all zoning districts:

- a. No fence may be located, constructed, or maintained in such a way as to obstruct the view of intersections by motorists and pedestrians.
- b. Fences shall not be located within seventy-five (75) feet of the centerline intersection of two (2) streets.
- c. No barbed wire or other sharp pointed metal fence and no electrically charged fence shall be permitted, unless after consideration, the Commission makes a determination that such materials are necessary for security purposes.
- d. A fence permit, issued by the Building Official, shall be required for all fences in all districts.

The maximum fence height allowed varies depending on what zoning district your property is located. Please view the fence requirements at www.haileycityhall.org/planning/zoningord.

The fence permit fee is \$30 and is paid at the time your application is submitted. You may pick up a fence permit application at City Hall or you may download one from www.haileycityhall.org/building/forms.

Please remember to complete the back side of the application which asks if you have accurately located your property pins, know the width of your street right-of-way, and know your front yard setback.
