Dear Applicant,

In an effort to preserve a sense of the history of the community, the City of Hailey adopted certain ordinances designed to create regulations regarding historic sites and buildings, and to preserve cultural landmarks, as part of a broader plan to promote preservation of the historic downtown area. As such, a procedure for the demolition of historic structures, constructed prior to 1941, was established. This procedure involves a 120 day review period, during which the City, the Hailey Historic Preservation Commission, or any other commission, organization, or individual may negotiate with the owner and with any other parties, in an effort to find a means of preserving the structure or building for the acquisition by gift, purchase, or exchange of the property or any interest therein.

The Hailey Historic Preservation Commission (HHPC) typically conducts meetings on the last Tuesday of the month. For more information on historic preservation, please consult the website or contact the Hailey Historic Preservation Commission.
