TO AUTHORIZE AND EMPOWER THE HAILEY CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAILEY, BLAINE COUNTY, IDAHO, TO CERTIFY AN ADDITIONAL TWO-YEAR LEVY

Shall the Hailey City Council of the City of Hailey, Blaine County, Idaho, be authorized and empowered to certify a two-year levy for the purpose of funding the lawful expenses to repair, design and construct sidewalks, bike paths, trails and bike-pedestrian infrastructure within existing streets, rights-of-way and public property to more safely move pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles on key streets through Hailey? This levy is estimated to collect Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) each year for two fiscal years commencing with the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016, through fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, for a total levy of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000).

The following statement is required by Idaho Code § 34-439A:

The purpose for which the two-year levy shall be used is to pay the lawful expenses to repair, design and construct sidewalks, bike paths, trails and bike-pedestrian infrastructure within existing streets, rights-of-way and public property to more safely move pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles on key streets through Hailey, for the two fiscal years beginning October 1, 2016, and ending September 30, 2018. The date of the City's special levy election is May 17, 2016. The amount estimated to be collected from the two-year levy is Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) each year for the two fiscal years for a total of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000).
