Hailey Public Art Fund

Tracy Anderson has put together a bake sale fund raiser. The total amount raised is \$163.30. Tracy also provided the Art's Commission with a "Potential Public Art Project List," in order to stay on track. Also, provided in this list are possible sites for future public art in public spaces.

Art Projects

Pat asked how the commission is able to get involve in a certain project that the city has planned. Pat asked, if the commission can pick a potential project and send a request to be involved to Tom Hellen. Welcome to Hailey Sign

Jim Spinelli has brought up the idea of a "Welcome to Hailey" sign. Jim also stated that he has funds from the Chamber of Commerce to donate towards the process of making the sign; Jim also stated he knows a few people willing to donate funds for a "Welcome to Hailey" sign.

Pat would like the board to discuss the process of making this sign possible and what we would need in order to complete the project. Pat informed the board we would need an Artist to design the sign. Physical material to design the sign; Placement of the sign;

Heather stated that the City of Hailey has future plans of sidewalks in the historic area to add or repair. The City of Hailey has a few sidewalk plans already in place in the Woodside Elementary School area that the Art's Commission can get involved in. Pat would like to know how the commission can become informed of the upcoming plans. Heather stated that she will advise Tom Hellen and Beth Robahn that the Arts Commission is interested in getting involved with the sidewalk master plan. Beth invited the commission to the workshop on December 15th 2008 at 6:30pm.
