Meeting Minutes

CALL TO ORDER:

Meeting was called to order at 4:15 p.m.

There were no public comments.

The October minutes were mixed up with another month, and will be redone. There was not a quorum of commissioners for the November meeting, so the discussions were not recorded.

Jim Keating and R.L. Rowsey were officially welcomed as new commissioners.

OLD BUSINESS:

The revised 2010-2011 budget was again distributed, and briefly discussed. Rowsey had several questions about the allocations and intended uses of certain categories.

The two RFPs for the Month of Art (sculpture along Main Street) and Night of Music were described. Packer will work on the Month of Art with Johnstone, and Spinelli will work on the Night of Music with Johnstone. The target release date is in early February.

NEW BUSINESS:

Anderson reviewed the Woodside Boulevard Complete Streets Initiative RFQ that is being distributed in January – the public art components will be artist designed bike racks. Johnstone will conduct a “how to apply” workshop for artists on January 20. Keating thought it was important to notify the Wood River Bike Coalition.

Michael Bulls presented the Rodeo Park plan. He summarized the history of the project, reviews by Planning and Zoning and City Council, and the proposed upcoming schedule. Bulls then went into detail on each of the five artists’ proposals (Bill Amaya, Ellen Nasvik, Troy Passey, Marie Stewart, Tom Teitge) and how their work will be integrated into the design of the ice rink, rodeo arena, skatepark and interpretive center. Rowsey asked how the artists will be identified, how there might be explanation of how and why

their works are important, especially how that might be incorporated into an explanatory brochure or “cell phone” activated guide. There was a discussion of how additional elements proposed by the artists might be incorporated into a second phase. Amaya volunteered to work with Anderson, Keating and Johnstone on potential additional fund raising. The motion was made and unanimously passed to forward the artists’ proposals to the Mayor and City Council on December 13. Johnstone and Bulls will present.

ADJOURN:

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made and seconded by Linda Packer. The meeting adjourned at 6:02 P.M.
