The Call to Artist specifies Blaine County residents. August 1, 2014 is the deadline to apply. Call to artists to be published in the newspaper- advertising out of HAHPC budget. Night of Music: So far not making progress. Several local businesses are already hosting different bands. Doing it on their own without the Night of Music we are suggesting. How can we help? Mapping different venues and bands? Music is scheduled beginning June 23- end of July. Need to get Power House information to complete schedule.

Requested- \$ 47,500.00 next year's budget. \$ 40,000. To be used for Welcome to Hailey sign. \$ 7,500. Regular programs (\$ 5,000. Arts Commission- \$ 2,500. Historic Preservation.)

We have \$ 4,600. To spend this year.

Historic Preservation: Bell Tower- Catholic Church- no progress.

Demolition request for building to be donated to the Hailey Fire Dept for training purposes- built 1920. More info to follow.

Master Plan – Art in Hailey-

Welcome Sign, cleanup of Arboretum, Bill Josie Tree Committee- support, Tom Tigge brass maps of WRV. Arbor Committee Kathy Nobel.

Create energy with Welcome sign- upper deck entrance to Arboretum. Gateway. Arbor Committee, Parks and Lands Board, Develop a View Corridor.

What happens if sign becomes birmmed? Another section off bike path? Arboretum needs more intentional entrances. Signage- Next year's budget parks maintenance. Three of four streams of Planning Communication.

Arbor Park and Land Board. Donations memorial plants- trees.
Movement- artistic expression married with parks and landscape. Inside-
view shed user experience. Education purpose that started Arboretum. ITD
Land- Rec Dist. manages.

Honeysuckles at north end of airport- chain link fence- soil conservation
plants.
