**HAILEY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
HOLDS PUBLIC WORKSHOPS**

(Hailey, Idaho) The Hailey Historical Preservation Commission (HHPC) is seeking volunteers and input for recommendations concerning preservation of historic buildings and the creation of an Old Hailey Historic District. We will hold meetings on Sept. 26 and Oct. 3 at 6:30 PM at Hailey City Hall.

Created first in 1987, then re-established in 2005, the purpose of the HHPC is to promote the historic, architectural, archaeological and cultural heritage, features and qualities of Hailey through the identification, evaluation, designation and protection of significant buildings and sites.

The HHPC is proud to announce that our city has become a Certified Local Government (providing access to grant monies and programs), we have obtained a grant, and are in the process of completing an historic inventory of the Hailey Townsite. We have received the honor of being designated an Idaho Heritage City, replete with placards at both ends of Hailey. As directed by the Comprehensive Plan, Hailey is working to establish and retain historic sites and buildings by creating an historic district, regulations and recognitions for the preservation of that area.

The upcoming meetings will introduce the HHPC, present recent accomplishments, recognize National Register properties and other outstanding preservation efforts, and discuss recommendations to create an Old Hailey Historic District and the adoption of procedures to designate Historic Properties.
