

## **Transportation Master Plan Meeting**

The City of Hailey invites community area residents to attend an upcoming public workshop to learn about and comment on potential improvements to the City's transportation system. The workshop will be held on Wednesday, January 17, 2007 from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. at Hailey City Hall.

Transportation (traffic) is one of the issues for which the City of Hailey receives numerous citizen phone calls and comments. Public comments range from requests for additional police speed enforcement to sidewalk repairs to desires for additional stop signs. The City of Hailey has been working during the past year with a consulting firm to develop a Transportation Master Plan to address these and other related important issues. The completed Transportation Master Plan will outline recommendations for improvements to the City's transportation system to meet the community's needs for the next 20 years. Some of the most significant elements in the draft plan include recommendations for Main St and River St improvements, pedestrian and bicycle facilities enhancements and system-wide safety improvements, street and sidewalk maintenance, capital improvement plans and future design standards.
