### CHANGES IN CITY OF HAILEY WATERING ORDINANCE

(Hailey, Idaho) On May 19, 2008 the Hailey City Council had their third reading of Ordinance 1007 and has reinstated the practice of odd-even irrigation of landscaping. This change means that properties with odd addresses can irrigate on odd days and even addresses can irrigate on even day. There is no watering allowed on the 31<sup>st</sup> of each month for all address. In addition, there is no watering allowed between the hours of 10 am – 6 pm every day of the week for every property. Be advised that this ordinance will be enforced and tickets will be issued to those who do not comply.

The Public Works Department encourages all homeowners with an irrigation system to spend some time either on their own or with a landscape company to make sure their system is in good shape for the season. In recent years there have been improvements made to the spray heads increasing their efficiencies which would reduce the length of time required for irrigation.
