A “Night of Music” in Hailey, Idaho

A Night of Music will be held Monday, July 13 for the second year in downtown Hailey. Live bands will play, for the most part outside, at many restaurants and bars, which occurs during the annual “July is A Month of Art in Hailey” celebration. Families will be able to walk the downtown business core along Main Street and several adjoining streets and enjoy a variety of free, live musical experiences.
