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City of Hailey Announces Fog Seal Project

Fog sealing is a maintenance process applied to streets to protect and lengthen their useful life. The City of Hailey has implemented this process in recent years, after identifying that it is less expensive than chip sealing but carries much of the same returns.

Four east-Hailey subdivisions are planned for fog sealing next week. The project is planned for Tuesday, June 30th, 2009, and may spill into Wednesday, July 1st, 2009 dependent upon weather conditions.

The project timeframe plans work to occur as follows:

- 9:00 a.m. in the Foxmoor Subdivision
- 11:00 a.m. in the Hiawatha Subdivision
- 2:00 p.m. in the Mother Lode Subdivision
- 4:00 p.m. in the Northridge Subdivision

To assist with proper sealing of the street in front of your property, please adhere to the following:

- Do not water your front lawns from 10:00 a.m. Monday, June 29, 2009 to 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 01, 2009.
- Driving on the fog seal will not be permitted for up to one (1) hour after application.
- Please plan to make alternative parking arrangements for your vehicles on this day to avoid being delayed in your driveway.
- Do not park any kind of vehicle or equipment along road ways.
- If it rains the fog seal application will be delayed.
- Protect children and pets from the sticky sealant, as it is difficult to clean off skin, hair and clothing.

The project will be finished when all roads are sealed.

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
