### **Hailey Police Department to Conduct Crosswalk Sting**

(Hailey, Idaho) – As summer approaches, the Hailey Police Department expects an increase in pedestrian traffic due to several planned events. The department will be taking a proactive approach to pedestrian safety again this year. On June 3<sup>rd</sup> a fail-to-yield to pedestrians in crosswalk sting at Main and Carbonate and Main and Galena will be conducted. The extra enforcement activity will begin at 1:00 p.m. and conclude at 5:00 p.m. A police officer in plain clothes will be crossing Main Street several times throughout the day. Motorists will be farther than 75 feet from the crosswalk before the officer steps off the curb. Anyone failing to yield to the officer will be cited. This will be the first of many planned pedestrian stings this year. The Hailey Police Department asks the motoring public to look for pedestrians at all times, and hopes everyone has a safe summer.
