Back to School Safety


Fall is in the air and that means back-to-school for the community's youth. Please be on the alert for children traveling to and from school, either on foot or by bicycle. Rules of the road regarding school buses should be strictly followed. With a little extra effort, we can all do our part to keep our young people out of harm's way.



Pedestrian Safety

The Hailey Police Department is doing its part to keep motorists alert to pedestrians on our city streets. Pedestrians can help by observing these safety responsibilities, provided for by the Idaho Code and/or the Hailey Municipal Code:

- A pedestrian shall obey the instructions of any traffic-control devices specifically applicable to him, unless otherwise directed by a peace officer.
- No pedestrian shall suddenly leave a curb or other place of safety and walk or run into the path of a vehicle which is so close as to constitute an immediate hazard.
- Every pedestrian crossing a roadway at any point other than within a marked crosswalk or within an unmarked crosswalk at an intersection shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles upon the roadway.
- No pedestrian shall cross a highway intersection diagonally unless authorized by traffic-control devices.
