THE 3 Rs



When it comes to environmental impact, recycling, waste reduction and reusing products are all important activities that save energy and save money.

REDUCE

- Buy products in concentrate or bulk
- Avoid products with toxic ingredients
- Repair or maintain equipment
- Buy more durable products
- Buy items made from recycled materials
- Remove your name from junk-mail lists

REUSE

- Reuse cloth, paper or plastic bags for shopping (keep them in your car)
- Share magazines with neighbors and friends
- Compost yard and food waste
- Use flatware or reusable plastic items for parties (collect in a separate bin)

RECYCLE

- It WORKS! Americans recycled (and composted) 34% of our waste last year
- Blaine County recycled 2,887,200 pounds last year
