## WINTER-WATER USAGE ISSUES:

It's time to think about your winter-water usage. The sewer-bond charge is reset in April, and it's based on winter-water usage (Nov.-Mar.). To lower your sewer-bond charge, it's recommended that you do the following by **October 22nd**:

- 1. Turn off sprinklers.** Water meters will be read on Oct. 23<sup>rd</sup>. Water used after Oct. 23<sup>rd</sup> will be part of your Nov. water usage.
- 2. Replace toilet flappers.** Hard water in Hailey makes toilet flappers wear out more often. If the flapper doesn't seal in your toilet tank, water is leaking.
- 3. Notify us if you will be running water for freeze protection.** The Freeze Protection form can be found on our website. Turn in completed forms to City Hall.
- 4. Check outside faucets.** Many faucets were turned on accidentally by snow falling off roofs last winter. Listen for running water and consider sheltering outdoor faucets.
