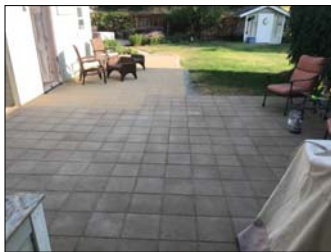
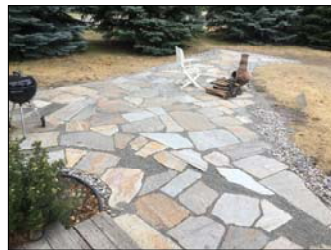
Water Conservation

Water Smarty Requests Extension of Grant Funds for 2019 Season

Water Smarty, the City's water conservation rebate program, has requested an extension of its grant funding through the 2019 landscape season. Both grantors have informally approved the request.
