

2020 Hailey Resiliency Program

The Community Development Department will contract with a part-time Resiliency Coordinator to coordinate Hailey Resiliency goals for 2020 and beyond. The Coordinator will advise the City as to how to lead by example. The Coordinator will advise steps as to how to get from here to there- a path forward towards achievable goals. The primary categories will be energy, water and waste.



Tasks include:

City Infrastructure and Policies

- Monthly meetings with the Hailey Climate Action committee
- Monthly staff reports to the City Council on progress
- Inventory and Update Benchmarking- carbon emission goals for city facilities, etc. (goals from 2008).
- Energy audit status review
- Review AIA 2030 Challenge and other similar examples (50% emissions reduction by 2030) and update Hailey goals accordingly
- Water- continue to incentives lower water use

Community-at large

- Commercial code updates
- Green building code enforcement
- Construction waste enforcement-waste diversion
- Green building code review and update
- Drought-tolerant zoning code

Regional coordination

- Participate in the development in a common set of goals
- Coordinate with Bellevue, Blaine County, Ketchum and Sun Valley on building codes, recycling and transfer station; other regional incentive programs such as recognition of businesses that avoid single-use plastics
