## **HAILEY POLICE DEPARTMENT PRESS RELEASE**

Re: Drug Trafficking Methamphetamine &  
Possession of Marijuana w/ Intent to Deliver Arrest

On 10/06/2013 at 5:58 PM, a traffic stop was conducted by the Hailey Police Department on a green 1998 Pontiac Grand Am at the intersection of Willow Drive and Woodside Boulevard as part of an on-going investigation. After conducting further investigation on scene, the driver, Lilia Carrillo-Duenas (24, of Hailey, ID) was placed under arrest for Failure to Purchase a Driver's License. During an inventory of the Pontiac, a green leafy substance with the appearance and odor of Marijuana, and paraphernalia associated with smoking Marijuana and Methamphetamine were located in the Pontiac. Lilia was then booked into the Blaine County Public Safety Facility for Failure to Purchase a DL, and Possession of Marijuana & Paraphernalia. The only other passenger in the Pontiac, Juan Carlos Alvarado-Sanchez (23, of Hailey, ID), was also charged and booked into the Public Safety Facility for Possession of Marijuana & Paraphernalia.

On 10/07/13 at 4:30 PM Hailey Police conducted a search of Lilia's residence located in the North Woodside Subdivision and found the following:

- Two small baggies with a crystal rock like substance along with drug weighing and packaging materials. The crystal rock like substance is presumed to be Methamphetamine and had a weight of 39.9 grams.
- A 24 ounce glass jar full of a green leafy substance, which is presumed to be Marijuana and had a weight of 2.27 ounces.
- A small baggie containing a crystal like substance, which is presumed to be Methamphetamine and had a total weight of 0.9 grams.

After conducting the search of Lilia's apartment, she was also charged and booked on Felony Drug Trafficking Methamphetamine & Felony Possession of Marijuana with the Intent to Deliver. The street value of the drugs recovered is valued at approximately \$4,500.

As of 10/09/13 at 8:00 AM, Lilia is still in custody at the Blaine County Public Safety Facility and being held on a \$32,000 bond, and Juan is being held on a \$2,000 bond.
