Hailey City Council Colleen Teevin Resigns Hailey Mayor Seeks to Fill City Council Seat

(Hailey, Idaho) –Hailey City Council member Colleen Teevin announced her resignation during the October 1, 2018 City Council meeting. She stated that since she was elected three years ago, many things in her personal and professional life had changed, and after careful consideration, she had determined to step down from her seat on the Hailey City Council.

The mayor is authorized by Idaho law to appoint a qualified resident to fill a vacant city council seat. Mayor Haemmerle plans to present an appointment within a month to the Hailey City Council, who will then consider and vote on the nomination. Mayor Haemmerle states, “I would like to interview any resident of Hailey interested in and with energy for the position. Let’s have a conversation.”

An appointed city council member will serve until the next city election, at which time voters have the opportunity to elect a city council member. In this case, the next election is November 2019.

Interested residents must be qualified electors of Hailey, meaning that they must reside within the city limits of Hailey for at least 30 days prior to seeking the appointment, they must be at least 18 years of age, and they must be a U.S. citizen.
