Winter Snow Removal

The Hailey Police Department wants to help you avoid an exorbitant tow bill and the inconvenience of having your car towed, by asking residents to follow the winter snow removal city ordinances.

It is unlawful for any person to park a motorized vehicle or non-motorized vehicle, trailer or camper on Main Street between McKercher Boulevard and Maple Street, on Broadford Road from Cedar Street to the City of Hailey city limits or on Bullion and Croy Streets between First Avenue and River Street for any period exceeding two hours between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

For all other locations in the city not mentioned above, the following ordinance is in effect. For any Right-of-Way with a paved street abutting an improved curb and gutter, it is unlawful for any person to park a motorized vehicle or non-motorized vehicle, trailer or camper within the Right-of-Way between the hours of 12:00 a.m. (midnight) to 7:00 a.m., each day from November 1st of each year to May 1st of the following year. For any Right-of-Way without a paved street abutting an improved curb and gutter, it is unlawful for any person to park a motorized vehicle or non-motorized vehicle, trailer or camper within six feet (6') of the edge of asphalt constructed by or on behalf of the within the Right-of-Way between the hours of 12:00 a.m. (midnight) to 7:00 a.m., each day from November 1st of each year to May 1st of the following year. This section also applies to the guest parking turnouts on Woodside Blvd.

Unfortunately the police department does not have the time to knock on doors and ask violators to move their cars during a snow event. Our only recourse is to tow cars for efficient snow removal. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
