- Introduction of updates to Title 18 Street Tree Standards; staff will present idea of adding Silva Cells standards to current standards in Title 18. HTC discussed other items **not** related to trees in Street standards, but no action taken on any recommendations. City staff will work on updated Title 18 street tree standards and will present this for a vote at April meeting.
- Discussion of ideas for Arbor Day tree planting. HTC discussed planting some more Honeylocusts near last year's planting. Item tabled until next meeting.
- Winter storm damage discussion: Chair expressed a concern over the large amount of broken branches on ROW trees – especially in Old Hailey and suggested that these trees should be a high priority for maintenance this year.
- Vacant seat on Hailey Tree Committee. Kelly will contact a friend about this opportunity.

- Updated Urban Forestry Plan (2019-2021) – no vote. Chair will present a new version at April meeting. We tabled discussion of the current Wood River Valley Tree Guide. Chair is working on a separate Street Tree list to supplement Title 18 Street tree standards.
