1. New Business Discussions

- Historic Demolition Application by Zions Bank for the structure located at 401 S. Main Street. The Applicant is seeking to reduce the 120-day waiting period, requesting a 30-day review period. The Applicant presented their request for approval and to reduce the review period to 30 days due to the short construction season to allow the Applicant to start the process for the new development once the existing building is demolished. The Commission agreed to the 30-day review period which will be noticed accordingly.
- Review Mural Submittals for SV Car Wash located at 817 S. 3rd Ave. The Commission reviewed and discussed the submittals for the Art Mural to be located on the western wall of the Sun Valley Car Wash Building. After reviewing each submittal, the Commission voted for their top two (2) designs. Staff will meet with the property owner to discuss the selected artists and will bring back their input at the meeting in May to further discuss and select the artist for the mural project as well as the next processes.
