New Business:

Recommendations for East Croy bike path:

Corner of Croy and Eastridge. Owner suggested Big Tooth maple. This is a shrub and will not be big enough to provide shade, HTC recommends Autumn Blaze or Japanese Lilac.

211, HTC recommends Autumn Blaze or Japanese Lilac.

210, HTC recommends Horse Chestnut, Honey Locust or Hackberry. This lot has questionable soil and HTC recommends possibly amending the soil here.

620 and 610, Ginko Honey Locust or Japanese Lilac.

Trees at these locations will be planted next spring.

202 S 3rd Ave. Owner requests pruning branch of tree in the ROW. Branch is hanging over vehicles in driveway. HTC gives permission to owner to remove branch themselves, or city can do it for them.

Hailey Automotive, HTC recommends Swamp White Oak
