

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Hailey Parks & Lands Board

Call to Order:

Call to order by Waters 5:59

Approval of Minutes:

Thayer moves to approve minutes of the March 23, 3033 meeting, seconded by Miner, passes unanimously.

Public Comment:

Skate park users gathered to share their thoughts on skate park improvements. They showed interest in adding “resi” (rubber matting) landing zones in high impact areas.

New Business:

Develop a list of goals for the year:

- Board agreed that this list should focus on skate park improvements. All agreed that most efficient use of time is to focus on one park at a time.
- Another priority identified for this year is improving water conservation by eliminating select irrigation.

Old Business:

Skate Park Improvements:

- Board considered updating signage to be larger (similar to the signs at Ketchum Skate Park)
 - Suggested additional rules to be added:
 - “Call your drop”
 - Helmets Required, additional padding recommended
 - Children ages 8 and under only with adult supervision
- Board agrees that removing central landscaping would benefit park users. Williams will research cost and feasibility.
- Wiederrick presented research on best supplies to fix deteriorating concrete, noted importance of developing schedule for maintenance that least impacts users:
 - Sickle Flex for caulking cracks \$9.75/tube
 - Ardex CD Fine \$50/bag for fixing larger patches
- Wiederrick proposed a concept for a permanent shade structure to be installed adjacent to existing concrete benches. Structure would be 20ft x 10ft, with a cantilevered roof to

provide additional shade. Hardscaping would need to be installed under structure and extended west to high point to alleviate irrigation and runoff problems.

- Board noted need to develop strategy for fixing/replacing Ice House gutters and protecting from future damage.
