# Hop Porter Park Grant:

### Curtis Park:

Board made a motion to preserve the integrity of all City Parks. Board recommends that the City
pursue preserving our property boundary if at all possible. Bob made motion, Penny seconded
passes unanimously.

# Kiwanis Park:

Board identified this park as a possible location to pilot adult exercise equipment. Board
expressed interest in pursuing this opportunity with St. Luke's to secure funding, make sure
equipment is durable and usable year-round, check with BCRD and gyms about what equipment
to provide. Boise- Ann Morrison park has a great outdoor gym option.
