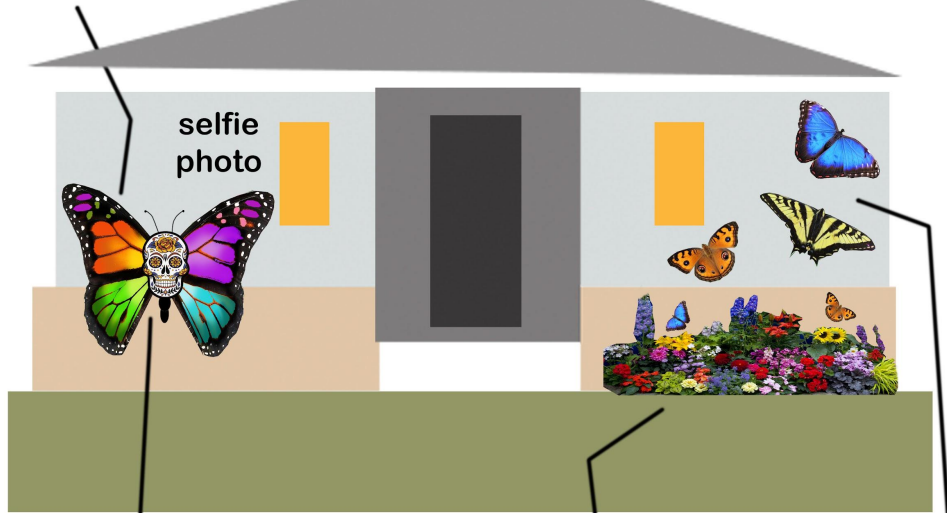

1. Phone Booth Project

- Pavers
 - o Public Works
 - Approved
 - Design: to extend the curb in a diagonal section
 - o Cost
 - Quote from Del Angels ~2,000
 - o Installation
 - 3 day duration
 - Trying to coincide the timing with painting the booths
 - o **Motion to approve the Del Angels quote for about \$2,000**
 - **Waller motions, Rowland seconds, all in favor**
 - **3:41 pm**
- Painting
 - o Schedule
 - Soon after August 8
 - o Color
 - Multiple fire-engine red colors to choose from
 - o Doors
 - Need doors at some point
 - Let's mount them first, then put on doors
- Securing the booths onto the pavers

- City may have time to do it in October
- Photos
 - Choose 12 from the packet
 - Discussion of collage
 - Keep it Hailey-centric, less Sun Valley
 - Mallory collection at the Hailey Library
 - Frank provide the reference number
- 2. Budget
- 3. General plan, rounded numbers
 - a. Unexpended balance cannot be carried over
 - b. Any excess from phone booths and utility box projects will go to deposit for mural artist
- 4. Utility Box
 - a. Photos of Diversity in the WRV
 - i. Mexican and Peruvian photos
 - 1. Romero will reach out to families
 - b. Also wrap the little white box if we have the approval, money, and photos
- 5. Mural
 - a. Why just the south wall?
 - b. Method
 - i. Green background
 - ii. Poo proposed the plywood method
 - iii. Toni thinks that we should not use the plywood method
 - 1. Could be temporary
 - iv. How do we make the wall smooth to accommodate Poo's style?
 - v. A different style mural would be more appropriate for the textured wall
 - vi. Or, change the wall to accommodate Poo's style
 - vii. Method influences materials, materials influences cost
 - viii. Romero's artist – John Estrada
 - ix. Collaboration between Poo and Romero's artist
 - c. Next steps
 - i. John Estrada to do a site visit and report back about availability, design, and quote
 - ii. Toni to communicate with Poo about flexibility on method and willingness to collaborate with another artist
 - iii. Make a decision before Aug. 22nd or Sept. 12th City Council Meeting

 - c. Mural guidelines
 - i. Gwen: Boise has mural guidelines, we should adopt our own
 - ii. Maintenance needs to be a part of the guidelines
 - 1. Owl Mural needs to be sealed
 - 2. We can use maintenance money for this
