Heritage Trees might be large **or** mature trees, **or** trees with unique botanical, aesthetic, ecological, **or** historical values, **or** trees with a special story. These Heritage trees can be nominated by anyone who would like to recognize a special tree or trees that are on their property or a neighbor's or a street or park tree, or other public tree as long as the nominee is in city limits.

You can nominate multiple trees in different locations. Any additional information about the tree(s) including importance to you personally is helpful but not required. After trees are designated as a **Heritage Tree(s)**, information about the tree will be shared with the public and the preservation and appropriate care of these trees will be strongly encouraged. A future goal is to show a selection of these Heritage Trees on a walking guide.
