### MAIN STREET CHIP SEAL PROJECT

The Idaho Transportation Department will be applying a chip seal coating for asphalt preservation on Main Street/Highway 75 between Fox Acres Road and McKercher Blvd in July. During this time, the City will also be chip sealing the side streets in this area. The Main Street project is scheduled to commence July 21, 2023. Citizens should expect traffic delays on Main Street as the project progresses through several weeks of construction. Traffic lanes on side streets will be closed intermittently.
