RUBBISH RATE INCREASE

Rubbish pickup and curbside recycling in Hailey are provided by Clear Creek Disposal, which has an exclusive franchise within Hailey city limits. Two factors are affecting curbside rates this year: an increase in labor costs and an increase in the "tipping" fees at the Milner Butte Landfill. 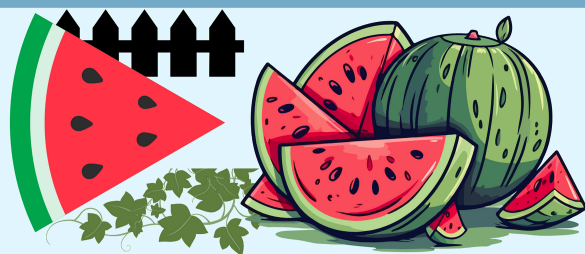
